

In order to join ACIFC Membership, companies are required to demonstrate that they meet the following criteria for membership:

All Members must:

- Be financially stable
- Have two years minimum trading period
- Operate a company health and safety policy
- Provide two concrete industrial flooring references at senior manager or director level
- Comply with the ACIFC Code of Conduct
- Comply with the ACIFC Complaints Procedure

Contractor and Associate Members must:

- Be UK-registered and based and active in the UK
- Hold Public/Employer's Liability insurances and Professional Indemnity insurance where required
- Submit the ACIFC Annual Return

Contractor Members must also:

- Have 75% of turnover generated from internal concrete industrial flooring
- Provide details of three internal concrete industrial flooring projects successfully completed within the last 12 months
- Operate quality procedures and meet industry performance standards
- Provide appropriate management and supervision of works
- Comply with current employment legislation
- Have an independently trained workforce
- Submit a copy of the companies audited accounts in respect of the last financial year
- Submit annual accident figures

Contractors engaged in internal concrete industrial flooring that do not meet all of the above requirements may be eligible for **Provisional Membership** subject to agreement to work towards meeting the outstanding requirements within a specified time period.

International Members must:

- Be internationally registered

If an International Member has subsidiaries trading in the UK that wish to use the ACIFC logo, they must be in UK membership (Contractor, Associate, or Provisional)
